REVISED – February 18<sup>th,</sup> 2014 By Unanimous Vote

#### **ARTICLE III - ELECTIONS**

Sec. 1. Elections shall be held at the October club meeting each even year. To run for office, the

member must be at the August club meeting and declare their interest in an officer or board position. The President shall appoint a nominating committee of three members, at the June club meeting. The Nominating Committee shall have the duty of placing in nomination the names of candidates for each of the various elective offices. Additional nominations may be made from the floor at the August club meeting provided they are presented by a member in good standing, and the nominated is in attendance at the meeting. The candidates receiving the greatest number of votes at the October club meeting for that office shall be declared elected.
